Market today: Mid-cap Stocks are Outperforming the VNIndex

The VNIndex continued to rally by 2.12 pts (+0.3%) and closed just above 705 pts. Market breadth widened as there were 160 gainers and 93 decliners. Investors have been eager to identify stocks that had positive Q4 earnings such as HBC, PNJ, and PTB. Large cap stocks, which are represented by the VN30, performed solidly today with some notable performers including PVD (+6.6%), HNG (+4.2%), and GMD (+0.3%). Oil & gas stocks including PVD, PVS, PVC, and PVT and securities stocks such as HCM, SSI and VND, were today's leaders.

We observed that invested capital has been moving from large-cap stocks to mid-cap stocks. In the HSX, investors focused on large-cap stocks one week prior to Tet. During that time, the average trading value of large-cap stocks accounted for 66% of the total trading volume of the HSX. However, things have been changing after Tet holiday. At the moment, the trading value of large-cap stocks has reduced by 59%. Mid-cap stocks have begun to be more actively traded, with its total trading value rising from 23.7% to 29.4% of the index after Tet. We also noticed an increase in trading value of small cap stock, but it has not been as significant as mid-cap stocks. The absolute average trade value in the HSX is around VND2,396 billion/session and has not changed much. **We can conclude that investors are currently eyeing mid-cap stocks.** Therefore, the VNIndex can slow down, as mid-cap stocks do not strongly impact the VNIndex' movement. However, if investors have good performing stocks (especially mid-cap stocks) in their portfolio, they should not be worried much about any potential correction of the VNIndex.
